Appointment of six members of the Advisory Committee on the United Nations  
Educational and Training Programme for Southern Africa

Note by the Secretary-General

1. In its resolution 33/42 of 13 December 1978, the General Assembly decided to enlarge the composition of the Advisory Committee on the United Nations Educational and Training Programme for Southern Africa by the addition of up to six members, on the basis of consultations by the Secretary-General with regional groups.
