APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS AND OTHER APPOINTMENTS: APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF AUDITORS

Note by the Secretary-General

1. As indicated in document A/42/103 of 19 February 1987, it will be necessary for the General Assembly, during its current session, to appoint the Auditor-General (or officer holding the equivalent title) of a Member State to fill the vacancy that will arise on 1 July 1988 in the membership of the Board of Auditors as a consequence of the expiration, on 30 June 1988, of the term of office of the Auditor-General of Ghana.
2. The Government of Ghana has nominated the Auditor-General of Ghana for reappointment to the Board of Auditors for a term of office beginning on 1 July 1988 and ending on 30 June 1991.
