Subject: **Post adjustment multiplier for New York****

1. In information circular ST/IC/1999/19 of 22 February 1999, staff members were informed that, upon implementation of the revised base salary scale effective 1 March 1999, revised post adjustment indices and multipliers would be established by the International Civil Service Commission (ICSC) for all duty stations. Changes in post adjustment multipliers due after 1 March 1999 will be effected on the basis of the movement of the newly consolidated post adjustment indices.
2. In accordance with the above-mentioned procedure, ICSC has determined that post adjustment multiplier 43 should apply for staff in the Professional and higher categories serving in New York, with effect from 1 March 1999. Consequently, effective 1 March 1999, the post adjustment multiplier for New York is being revised from 46.5 to 43.
3. The annual amount of post adjustment at multiplier 43 for each salary level and step is shown in the annex to the present circular.
4. The implementation of the revised post adjustment multiplier will be reflected in the end of March 1999 payroll.
