Article 29

Denunciation

It should be noted that the translation or the Arabic wording of article 29 is inaccurate and contrary to the legal concept intended by the article. Accordingly the word "Withdrawal" should replace the word "Denunciation" used as the title for the article.

This amendment of course requires consistency between the terms used and the proposed amendment and thus the text should read as follows:

"The State Party may withdraw from the Convention by addressing a notification in writing to the United Nations Secretary-General. The withdrawal will take effect one year after receipt of the notification by the Secretary-General."
