1999/... <u>Human rights and the follow-up to the guidelines</u> for the regulation of computerized personal data files

The Commission on Human Rights, referring to the guidelines for the regulation of computerized personal data files (E/CN.4/1990/72) adopted by the General Assembly in its resolution 45/95 of 14 December 1990, and taking note of the report of the Secretary-General prepared pursuant to Commission decision 1997/122 of 16 April 1997 (E/CN.4/1999/88) decides:

(a) to withdraw the question from its agenda, since the applicableguidelines are progressively being taken into consideration by States;

(b) to request the Secretary-General to entrust the competent inspection bodies with the task of ensuring the implementation of the guidelines by the organizations concerned within the United Nations system.
