LETTER DATED 3 JULY 1980 FROM THE ACTING PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED NATIONS COUNCIL FOR NAMIBIA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to bring to your attention certain developments in Namibia which the Council for Namibia views with the utmost gravity.

According to available reports the illegal South African administration in Namibia has established a so-called Council of Ministers in the territory which it illegally occupies. These initiatives are in violation of resolution 439 (1978) and constitute an additional indication of South Africa's attempt to undermine the implementation of Security Council resolutions 385 (1976) and 435 (1978).

I would appreciate your kind assistance in bringing these developments to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
