- 1. <u>Change</u> the title to: "Stereotyping of religions"
- 2. Replace pp. 5 with:

" $\underline{\text{Deeply concerned}} \text{ at the negative stereotyping of some religions,}$  including many minority religions"

- 3. <u>Insert</u> a new pp. 5 <u>bis</u>:
  - "<u>Acknowledging</u> the concern of some Governments that Islam is often associated with human rights violations and with terrorism"
- 4. <u>Delete</u> the last part of pp. 8, beginning with "thereby", and replace it with:
  - " ... therefore facilitating a better understanding of human rights,"

- 5. In op. 1, <u>replace</u> "to spread intolerance against Islam" with: "to spread negative religious stereotypes"
- 6. Replace op. 2 with:

"Expresses its appreciation for the efforts of many countries and
individuals to combat ignorance of and negative stereotyping of
religions;"

- 7. Replace op. 4 with:
  - "Invites the High Commissioner for Human Rights to organize a seminar for Governments, non-governmental organizations and the media to discuss stereotyping of Islam with relation to human rights;"
- 8. In op. 5,  $\underline{\text{replace}}$  "attacks against Islam and attempts to defame it" with:

"negative stereotyping of religions"
