30. In 1998, competitive examinations have been held in 17 countries (Angola, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Djibouti, Italy, Japan, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Maldives, Micronesia, Mozambique, Namibia, Norway, Romania, Turkey, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and Viet Nam). The competitive examination which had been scheduled for the Congo in 1998 was cancelled. Fifty-two successful candidates from the 1996 examinations were placed on roster, 20 of whom have been placed at the P-2 level and six at the P-3 level; from the 1997 examinations, 53 successful candidates were rostered, 12 of whom have been placed at the P-2 level as at 30 June 1998.
