Subject: World Health Assembly - WHO

<u>International Labour Conference - ILO</u>

- 1. The fifty-second session of the World Health Assembly and the eighty-seventh session of the International Labour Conference will be held at the Palais des Nations from 17 to 25 May and 1 to 17 June 1999, respectively.
- 2. Heads of State, high-ranking officials and many delegates will be attending these events at the United Nations Office at Geneva. For obvious security reasons, vehicular and pedestrian access to and movement within the Palais may be restricted. The necessary steps should therefore be taken to avoid any inconvenience during these meetings by strictly complying with the instructions of the Security and Safety Section.
- 3. Some parts of the Palais will be designated as "High Security Areas" during these meetings. Everyone is requested to observe the traffic signs and follow the instructions given by officers of the Security and Safety Section. In this connection, the attention of all staff members is drawn to information circular IC/Geneva/4261 dated 11 November 1996 concerning "Access to the Palais des Nations".

4. Some car parks will be reserved for the above conferences, as follows:

- from 14 to 25 May: P-3 (lower)

- from 17 to 25 May: All of P-3 and P-5 (lower)

- from 26 to 31 May: One section of P-5 (lower) (door 13 side)

- from 1 to 17 June: All of P-3 and P-5 (lower)

5. The Pregny gate will remain open 24 hours every day.

The railway gate will be open between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on working days only, depending on events outside.

The Place des Nations gate will be closed throughout the conference period, but the pedestrian entrance will be open between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m., depending on events outside.
