Letter dated 25 November 1987 from the Permanent Representative of Pakistan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Further to my letter dated 24 November 1987 (A/42/830-S/19307), I have the honour to report to you the following serious incidents in violation of Pakistan territory from the Afghanistan side, which occurred on 15 November 1987:

On 15 November 1987, between 1130 and 1655 hours, Afghan armed forces fired 21 rounds of artillery, which landed in the Nawa Pass area in the Mohmand Agency. As a result, 100 feet of water pipeline was damaged.

Again on 15 November 1987, between 1430 and 1615 hours, Afghan armed forces fired 36 tank rounds, which landed in the village Sohe area in the Chaman sector. As a result, two Afghan refugees were killed.

The Afghan Chargé d'affaires was summoned to the Foreign Office at Islamabad on the morning of 23 November 1987, and a strong protest was lodged with him over the unprovoked attacks. He was asked to inform his authorities that if such attacks did not cease the entire responsibility for the serious consequences would rest on the Kabul authorities.

I request you to have this letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 31, 72, 129, 134 and 138, and of the Security Council.
