The meeting was called to order at 11.25 a.m.

Agenda item 5: Election of the officers of the Main Committees

1. **The Chairperson** recalled that in accordance with rule 99 (a) of the rules of procedure, as amended by General Assembly resolutions 56/509, paragraph 2 (c), and 58/126, annex B, paragraph 9, all the Main Committees were required to elect a chairman and a full bureau at least three months before the opening of the session.

2. Ms. Ochir (Mongolia) had been nominated for election to the office of Chairperson for the sixty-fifth session. In the absence of further nominations and in accordance with rule 103 of the rules of procedure, he would take it that the Committee wished to elect Ms. Ochir (Mongolia) Chairperson.

3. *Ms. Ochir (Mongolia) was elected Chairperson by acclamation.*

4. **Ms. Ochir** (Mongolia) thanked the Group of Asian States for nominating her and the Committee for electing her. The Committee had an important mandate to fulfil during the sixty-fifth session of the General Assembly in following up on the high-level plenary meeting on the Millennium Development Goals to be held in September 2010, and in addressing other pressing issues such as climate change. In performing her duties as Chairperson, she would build upon the successful work of the current Bureau and cooperate with all Committee members.

5. **The Chairperson** said that the Group of Eastern European States and the Group of Western European and Other States had nominated, respectively, Ms. Würtz (Hungary) and Mr. Lundberg (Finland) for the posts of Vice-Chairpersons.

6. *Ms. Würtz (Hungary) and Mr. Lundberg (Finland) were elected Vice-Chairpersons by acclamation.*

7. **The Chairperson** said that the election of the remaining Vice-Chairperson, to be nominated by the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States, and of the Rapporteur, to be nominated by the Group of African States, would be held at a later date.
