1. At its 45th meeting, on 25 November 1987, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/42/39) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution I recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 38 of its report (A/42/751). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/42/SR.45).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution I recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 38 of its report (A/42/751), subprogramme 4 "Training in disarmament" would be renamed "The United Nations disarmament fellowship, training and advisory services programme", no changes would be required in the programme narrative under that subprogramme, and no additional appropriation would be required under section 2B of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1988-1989.
