## Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 45th meeting, on 25 November 1987, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/42/43) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 8 of its report (A/42/753).
