APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS AND OTHER APPOINTMENTS

Appointment of members of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 53rd meeting, on 3 December 1987, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/42/105) concerning the vacancies in the membership of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal that will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of two of its members on 31 December 1987.
2. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/42/35) containing the names of two persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment to the Administrative Tribunal.
3. The Fifth Committee decided to recommend the appointment to the United Nations Administrative Tribunal, for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 1988, of Mr. Francisco Forteza (Uruguay) and Mr. Ioan Voicu (Romania).
4. The representatives of Denmark (on behalf of the members of the European Community), New Zealand (also on behalf of Australia and Canada), the United States of America, Norway (also on behalf of Iceland and Sweden) and Japan spoke in explanation of position.
