LETTER DATED 28 SEPTEMBER 1992 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The members of the Council have taken note of your report contained in document S/24581. They look forward to a positive approach by the parties to the forthcoming round of face-to-face talks on Cyprus and recall Security Council resolution 774 (1992) in which the Council expressed the expectation that an overall framework agreement would be concluded in 1992.

The members of the Council look forward with interest to the holding of further consultations at an early date between the Secretraiat and troop-contributing States and to receiving the report of the Secretary-General pursuant to Security Council resolution 759 (1992), paragraph 2, as soon as possible in the light of the progress made in the face-to-face talks.

In this context, the members of the Council recall the statement made to the press on 12 December 1991, in which the President of the Security Council said that the members of the Council had agreed to keep the question of the financing of the United Nations Peace-Keeping Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP) under review as a matter of urgency.
