At its 54th meeting, on 4 December 1987, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/42/55/Rev.1) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/42/L.11/Rev.1. The related reports of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions and the Committee on Conferences were presented orally by their Chairmen.

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/42/L.11/Rev.1, no modification would be required in the work programme described in the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1988-1989 in respect of section 5A, as the subject-matter has already been covered by paragraph 5A.4 (b) (ii) of that section and that no additional appropriation over and above those already requested under sections 5A and 29 of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1988-1989 would be required.
