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LETTER DATED 29 SEPTEMBER 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE  
OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED  
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to your attention the following instances of violations by Iraq of the terms of the cease-fire between the two countries.

1. On 23 March 1992, at 1510 hours, four Iraqi forces clothed in green outfits and aboard a command Jeep visited Iraqi defence positions at the geographical coordinates of NC 578-390 on the map of Sumar, west of border pillar 40/5 in no man's land.
2. On 25 March 1992, at 1030 hours, about 30 Iraqi forces were observed being trained at the geographical coordinates of NC-53-37 on the map of Sumar, south-west of border pillar 40/5 in no man's land.
3. On 25 March 1992, 11 Iraqi vehicles were seen trafficking at the geographical coordinates of NE 98-51 and NE 96-53 on the map of Marivan, north-west of border pillars 95 and 94/6 in no man's land.
4. On 26 March 1992, at 0800 hours, 18 Iraqi forces were observed constructing a bunker and digging a trench at the geographical coordinates of ND 399-109 on the map of Khosravi, west of border pillar 55/3 in no man's land.
5. On 26 March 1992, 15 Iraqi vehicles were observed trafficking at the geographical coordinates of NE 96-53 and NE 96-51 on the map of Marivan, north of border pillar 94/6 in no man's land.
6. On 28 March 1992, at 1250 hours, five Iraqi forces aboard a vehicle were observed visiting at the geographical coordinates of QA 306-815 on the map of Nahr-Anbar, west of border pillar 22/30 in no man's land.
7. On 28 March 1992, at 1900 hours, 11 Iraqi forces aboard an IFA vehicle joined other Iraqi forces stationed at the geographical coordinates of NC 58-38 on the map of Sumar, south of border pillar 40/5 in no man's land.

8. On 29 March 1992, at 1000 hours, five Iraqi forces got off a vehicle at the geographical coordinates of QA 30-81 on the map of Nahr-Anbar, west of border pillar 22/30 in no man's land and left the area after 10 minutes.
9. On 29 March 1992, at 1545 hours, three Iraqi forces were observed making observation at the geographical coordinates of QA 30-81 on the map of Nahr-Anbar, west of border pillar 22/30 in no man's land. They left the area at 1600 hours.
10. On 31 March 1992, 12 Iraqi vehicles were observed trafficking at the geographical coordinates of NE 96-52 and NE 98-51 on the map of Marivan, around border pillars 94/6 and 95 in no man's land.
11. On 1 April 1992, at 1520 hours, three Iraqi forces were observed installing a row of barbed wire at the geographical coordinates of NC 473-549 on the map of Sumar, between border pillars 44/7 and 44/8 in no man's land.
12. On 1 April 1992, 16 Iraqi vehicles were observed trafficking at the geographical coordinates of NE 96-53 and NE 98-51 on the map of Marivan, around border pillars 94/6 and 95 in no man's land.
13. On 5 April 1992, 12 Iraqi heavy and light vehicles were observed trafficking at the geographical coordinates of NE 96-53 and NE 98-51 on the map of Marivan, around border pillars 94/6 and 95 in no man's land.
14. On 6 April 1992, at 0830 hours, five Iraqi forces were conducting observations from the roof of Chalani sentry post at the geographical coordinates of NC 431-655 on the map of Naft-Shahr in no man's land.
15. On 6 April 1992, at 1600 hours, two Iraqi forces fired their weapons in the geographical coordinates of NC 432-665 on the map of Naft-Shahr in no man's land.
16. On 7 April 1992, 12 Iraqi vehicles were observed trafficking at the geographical coordinates of NE 96-52 and NE 98-51 on the map of Marivan in no man's land.
17. On 8 April 1992, 12 Iraqi vehicles were observed trafficking at the geographical coordinates of NE 96-53 and NE 98-51 on the map of Marivan, north-west of border pillar 94/6 in no man's land.
18. On 6, 7 and 8 April 1992, Iraqi forces reinforced their forces with the capacity of a group and constructed individual group bunkers at the geographical coordinates of QV 55-52 on the map of Jofeir, north of border pillar 14A/3 and south of border pillar 14B in no man's land.
19. On 8 April 1992, at 1340 and 1450 hours, Iraqi forces fired four 130-mm gun shells from the geographical coordinates of ND 35-16 on the map of Khosravi at the geographical coordinates of ND 43-11 on the map of Khosravi in the territory of the Islamic Republic of Iran, around border pillar 56.

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20. On 9 April 1992, at 0800 hours, 10 Iraqi forces were observed constructing a bunker at the geographical coordinates of NC 60-32 on the map of Kani-Sheikh, south of border pillar 40 in no man's land.
21. On 10 April 1992, at 0900-1600 hours, two Iraqi loaders were observed in activity at the geographical coordinates of PB 353-435 on the map of Kuh-tunnel, south of border pillar 26/2 in no man's land.
22. On 11 April 1992, at 1150 hours, seven Iraqi forces were observed restoring a bunker at the geographical coordinates of QA 017-949 on the map of Meimeh, south-east of border pillar 24/3 in no man's land.
23. On 15 April 1992, at 1200 hours, Iraqi forces deployed a Dush-k machine-gun at the geographical coordinates of ND 398-130 on the map of Khosravi, border pillar 56/1 in no man's land.
24. On 16 April 1992, at 0800 hours, a number of Iraqi forces stationed at Al-Sheib sentry post restored an observation post and a 60-mm mortar position at the geographical coordinates of QA 701-215 on the map of Chazabeh, south of border pillar 16 in no man's land.
25. On 16 April 1992, at 2000 hours, two Iraqi officers, who were accompanied by two armed men and 11 soldiers, conducted observation at the geographical coordinates of NC 647-275 on the map of Kani-Sheikh, border pillar 39/3 in no man's land.
26. On 18 April 1992, two Iraqi forces as well as a bulldozer were seen in activity at the geographical coordinates of QA 300-810 on the map of Nahr-Anbar, west of border pillar 22/30 in no man's land.
27. On 22 April 1992, a number of Iraqi infantry men were observed trafficking and conducting training exercises at the geographical coordinates of NC 583-331 on the map of Kani-Sheikh, west of border pillar 40/1 in no man's land.
28. On 22 April 1992, a number of Iraqi infantry men were observed trafficking and conducting training exercises at the geographical coordinates of ND 414-102 on the map of Khosravi, around border pillar 55/1.
