> REPORT OF THE UNITED NATIONS COMMISSION ON INTERNATIONAL TRADE LAW ON THE WORK OF ITS TWENTIETH SESSION

> Brazil, Burkina Faso, Central African Republic, Chad, Côte d'Ivoire, Egypt, France, Guinea, Mali, Mauritania, Morocco, Niger, Portugal, Rwanda, Senegal, Spain and Togo: amendments to draft resolution A/C.6/42/L.15

1. Modify the fifth preambular paragraph as follows:

"Taking note of the draft Convention, adopted by the Commission at its twentieth session,"

2. Insert the following new operative paragraph 2:

"<u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to draw the attention of all States to the draft Convention, to ask them to submit the observations and proposals they wish to make on the draft Convention before 30 April 1988 and to circulate these observations and proposals to all Member States before 30 June 1988;"

3. Replace the present paragraph 2 with the following paragraph 3:

"Decides to consider, at its forty-third session, the draft Convention on International Bills of Exchange and International Promissory Notes, with a view to its adoption at that session, and to create to this end, in the framework of the Sixth Committee, a working group that will meet at the beginning of the session, in order to consider the observations and proposals made by States."
