apportionment of the costs of peace-keeping operations  
financed through assessed contributionsReport of the Secretary-General

1. In paragraph 6 of its resolution 46/240 of 22 May 1992, the General Assembly requested the Secretary-General to report to the Assembly at its forty-seventh session on anomalies in the allocation of countries to the four groups set out in Assembly resolution 43/232, as adjusted by the Assembly in its resolutions 44/192 B, 45/269 and 46/198 A and applied as an ad hoc arrangement to the financing of the United Nations Observer Mission in El Salvador, taking into account Assembly resolution 46/206 of 20 December 1991 and other relevant resolutions of the Assembly, including resolution 3101 (XXVIII) of 11 December 1973. A similar request was made in paragraph 6 of General Assembly resolution 46/222 B of 22 May 1992.

2. In this connection, it is recalled that an earlier report of the Secretary-General on the same subject was submitted to the General Assembly in 1989 (A/44/605/Add.2). That report referred to the provisions of resolution 3101 (XXVIII) and the original establishment of the four groups of countries, namely, (a) the States permanent members of the Security Council; (b) specifically named economically developed Member States that are not permanent members of the Security Council; (c) economically less developed Member States; and (d) economically less developed Member States that were specifically named. The report also provided an overview of the composition of the four groups in 1973 and 1989, with particular reference to countries designated as least developed.

3. The four amounts specified in resolution 3101 (XXVIII) were established by a methodology intended to produce the following results: the Member States in group (d) would pay 10 per cent of the assessment rates established for the regular budget, those in group (c) would pay 20 per cent, those in group (b) would pay 100 per cent and those in group (a) would pay 100 per cent plus the amounts not otherwise apportioned. Within each group, according to the terms of the resolution, the amount appropriated was to be distributed among the respective group members on the basis of the relative weight of each group member's regular rate of assessment in relation to the total rate for the group.

4. Since 1989, the composition of the groups has changed as a result of Spain's voluntary move from group (c) to group (b) and the simultaneous moves of Poland from group (b) to group (c) and of the Central African Republic, Equatorial Guinea, Gambia, Mauritania, Myanmar, Sierra Leone and Togo from group (c) to group (d) (see resolution 44/192 B of 21 December 1989). As a result of the move from group (c) to group (d) of the latter seven Member States, all States designated as least developed countries before 1989 were placed in group (d).

5. The composition of the groups has been modified subsequently due to the increase in the number of Member States resulting from the addition of Namibia and Liechtenstein (see resolution 45/269 of 27 August 1991), the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Estonia, the Federated States of Micronesia, Latvia, Lithuania, the Marshall Islands and the Republic of Korea (see resolution 46/198 A of 20 December 1991). The resulting composition of the four groups is reflected in annex I along with the current rates of assessment. Furthermore, six additional countries have been designated as least developed countries, 1/ five of which are in group (c), as indicated by footnote c in annex I. The sixth country has been in group (d) since its admission to the Organization.

6. In addressing anomalies in the allocation of countries to the four groups, the General Assembly may wish to consider the automatic allocation of least developed countries to group (d). It may also wish to consider allocation to group (d) of least developed countries only. Currently, group (d) includes 14 Member States which are not least developed countries. Another possible solution would be to have a separate additional group for least developed countries. More generally, the question of addressing anomalies through an increase in the number of groups, could be considered.

7. A criterion, which might be used in determining anomalies, is per capita national income. The 1980-1989 averages in United States dollars are shown in column 4 of the table in annex I. For the sake of completeness, figures are shown for all Member States, including new Member States not yet allocated to a group.

8. It can be gathered from these data that wide variations in the level of per capita national income averages exist within each of the four groups. Averages range from \$333 to \$14,247 in group (a), from \$1,962 to \$18,362 in

group (b), from \$80 to \$17,495 in group (c), and from \$110 to \$2,651 in group (d), and there is considerable overlap among groups.

9. A starting-point for the debate on the elimination of perceived anomalies might be the illustrative table contained in annex II. It provides the percentage shares of Member States regrouped on the following basis:

(a) The methodology used for apportionment of costs for peace-keeping operations remains unchanged;

(b) Group (a) is unchanged;

(c) All least developed countries are allocated to group (d);

(d) Group (d) consists of least developed countries only;

(e) Countries with 1980-1989 per capita national income averages at or above \$5,000 are allocated to group (b) and the remainder to group (c).

10. It should be noted that annex II includes all current Member States of the United Nations. For the new Member States and for Belarus, Georgia, the Russian Federation and Ukraine, the rates of assessment proposed by the Committee on Contributions in its report to the General Assembly <sup>2/</sup> are used.

11. Similar alternative illustrative tables could be prepared on request at the time of the consideration of this report by the Assembly.
