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LETTER DATED 7 OCTOBER 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE  
OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS  
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to your attention the following instances of violations by Iraq of the terms of the cease-fire between the two countries.

1. On 5 May 1992, 20 Iraqi vehicles were observed moving from the geographical coordinates of NE 9653 and NE 9851 on the map of Marivan to Kuh Maroo and into the no man's land north of border pillar 94/6 and 95.
2. On 5 May 1992, at 0950 and 1000 hours an Iraqi crane was observed in activity at the geographical coordinates of QA 3081 on the map of Nahr-Anbar, west of border pillar 22/30.
3. On 6 May 1992, 20 Iraqi vehicles were observed moving from the geographical coordinates of NE 9653 and NE 9851 on the map of Marivan to Kuh Maroo and into the no man's land north of border pillar 94/6 and 95.
4. On 7 May 1992, three Iraqi soldiers aboard a patrol carrying two wireless communication equipment entered the no man's land from the geographical coordinates of QA 701-212 towards the geographical coordinates of QA 102-515 on the map of Chazbeh, south of border pillar 16. After inspecting the existing bunkers, they left the area.
5. On 9 May 1992, 13 Iraqi vehicles were observed moving around the geographical coordinates of NE 96-53 and NE 98-51 on the map of Marivan, north of border pillar 94/6 and 95.
6. On 10 May 1992, four Iraqi forces were observed digging a trench at the geographical coordinates of NC 522-972 on the map of Kharatha, west of border pillar 46.
7. On 10 May 1992, Iraqi forces were observed constructing an observation post and defence positions at the geographical coordinates of QA 010-924 and QA 017-940 on the map of Meimeh, south of border pillar 24/2 and 24/3.

8. On 11 May 1992, 23 Iraqi vehicles were observed moving around the geographical coordinates of NE 96-53 and NE 98-51 on the map of Marivan, from Kakhlan village to Kuh Maroo, north of border pillar 94/6 and 95.
9. On 12 May 1992, 25 Iraqi vehicles were observed moving at the geographical coordinates of NE 96-53 and NE 98-51 on the map of Marivan, north of border pillar 94/6 and 95.
10. On 13 May 1992, 23 Iraqi vehicles were observed moving in the no man's land at the geographical coordinates of NE 96-51 and NE 98-51 on the map of Marivan, north of border pillar 94/6 and 95.
11. On 14 May 1992, 16 Iraqi vehicles were observed moving in the no man's land at the geographical coordinates of NE 9651 and NE 9851 on the map of Marivan, north of border pillar 94/6 and 95.
12. On 15 May 1992, at 1700 hours, 20 Iraqi forces fully equipped were disembarked and stationed at the geographical coordinates of ND 395-109 and the geographical coordinates at ND 398-112 on the map of Khosravi, west of border pillar 55/3 and 55/4 in the no man's land.
13. On 16 May 1992, 21 Iraqi vehicles were observed moving in the no man's land at the geographical coordinates of NE 98-51 and NE 96-53 on the map of Marivan, north of border pillar 94/6 and 95.
14. On 17 May 1992, 27 Iraqi vehicles were observed moving in the no man's land, between the geographical coordinates of NE 9851 and NE 9653 on the map of Marivan, north of border pillar 94/6 and 95.
15. On 18 May 1992, at 0850 hours, 15 Iraqi forces were observed inspecting the area at the geographical coordinates of NC 505-835 on the map of Seizdeh, in the no man's land and west of border pillar 46/6.
16. On 18 May 1992, 15 Iraqi soldiers were observed being trained in the no man's land at the geographical coordinates of ND 414-102 on the map of Khosravi, west of border pillar 55/1.
17. On 19 May 1992, 18 Iraqi vehicles were seen moving around the geographical coordinates of NE 9851 and NE 9653 on the map of Marivan, in the no man's land and north of border pillar 94/6 and 95.
18. On 20 May 1992, at 1000 hours, five Iraqi forces aboard a white jeep moved from Khaneh-Kharabeh fork at the geographical coordinates of NC 426-663 on the map of Naft-Shahr in the no man's land towards the Chalani sentry post at the geographical coordinates of NC 431-655 on the map of Naft-Shahr. After an hour of observation, they left the area.
19. On 20 May 1992, at 1240 hours, an Iraqi vehicle carrying six Iraqi forces were observed moving around the geographical coordinates of PB 353-435 on the map of Kuh-Tunnel in the no man's land south of border pillar 25/11 in the

Changouleh area. It stopped for 10 minutes, disembarking five passengers, and moved back towards the west.

20. On 20 May 1992, 12 Iraqi forces were seen moving around the geographical coordinates of NE 9653 and NE 9851 on the map of Marivan, north of border pillar 94/6 and 95.

21. On 21 May 1992, nine Iraqi vehicles were observed moving at the geographical coordinates of NE 9851 and NE 9653 on the map of Marivan in the no man's land - from Kakhlan village to Kuh Maroo and north of border pillar 94/6 and 95.

22. On 21 May 1992, at 0800-1030 hours, two groups of 10 and 15 Iraqi soldiers were observed constructing bunkers at the geographical coordinates of ND 407-105 and ND 404-102 on the map of Khosravi, in the no man's land and west of border pillar 55/1.

23. On 21 May 1992, at 1415 hours, 15 Iraqi forces and an Iraqi clad in civilian clothing aboard a bus entered a base around the geographical coordinates of QA 300-810 on the map of Nahr-Anbar, west of border pillar 22/30 in the Sharhani area. They left the area after inspecting it.

24. On 21 May 1992, at 1815 hours, Iraqi forces began stationing fresh forces at the geographical coordinates of NC 682-241, NC 51-01 and NC 70-23 on the map of Kani-Sheikh and Halaleh, south of Abu Gharib Kuh, north of Meimak heights, and north-west of border pillar 39, and 39/1 in the no man's land.

25. On 22 May 1992, 12 members of the dissolved Democrat Party supported financially and weaponry-wise by Iraq were observed at the geographical coordinates of NF 2526 on the map of Alavan, north of border pillar 116/2 and north-west of border pillar 116/3 in the no man's land.

26. On 23 May 1992, 20 Iraqi vehicles were observed moving at the geographical coordinates of NE 9851 and NE 9653 on the map of Marivan, in the no man's land and around border pillar 94/6 and 95.

27. On 23 May 1992, at 0800 hours, an Iraqi vehicle carrying 22 soldiers stopped at the geographical coordinates of QA 017-940 on the map of Meimeh in the no man's land and south-west of border pillar 24/2 and disembarked 12 soldiers.

28. On 24 May 1992, 16 Iraqi vehicles were observed moving at the geographical coordinates of NE 9653 and NE 9851 on the map of Marivan in the no man's land from Kakhlan to Maroo, around border pillar 94/6 and 95.

29. On 25 May 1992, 27 Iraqi vehicles were seen moving at the geographical coordinates of NE 9851 and NE 9653 on the map of Marivan in the no man's land and around border pillar 94/6 and 95.

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30. On 26 May 1992, 25 Iraqi vehicles were observed moving at the geographical coordinates of NE 9851 and NE 9653 on the map of Marivan, from Maroo to Kakhlan in the no man's land, and around border pillar 94/6 and 95.

31. On 26 May 1992, two Iraqi officers aboard a command jeep began inspecting the area from the geographical coordinates of NC 6129 on the map of Kani-Sheikh, south of border pillar 39/7 to the geographical coordinates of NC 6427 on the map of Kani-Sheikh south-west of border pillar 39/4 and south of border pillar 39/5 in the no man's land.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the Security Council.
