



REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CONFERENCES

Addendum

CHAPTER I

ORGANIZATIONAL MATTERS AND PROGRAMME OF WORK

1. Following the adoption of its report (A/35/32), the Committee on Conferences held four meetings between 2 July and 12 September 1980, at which it dealt exclusively with matters related to the calendar of conferences and meetings of the United Nations. A list of documents submitted to the Committee by the Secretariat appears in annex I.

CHAPTER II

CALENDAR OF CONFERENCES AND MEETINGS

A. Matters related to, and intersessional departures from, the approved calendar for 1980

1. Changes in the conference programme

2. The Committee considered two further requests for changes in the approved calendar of conferences and meetings for 1980.

3. The Committee decided not to approve the request of the Group of Experts on the Relationship between Disarmament and International Security to change the venue of its 8 to 29 August 1980 session from New York to Vienna. The Committee, however, agreed to postpone the session to 8 to 19 September 1980.

4. The Committee also decided not to approve the request by the Group of Governmental Experts on the Relationship between Disarmament and Development to change the venue of its 15 to 26 September 1980 session from New York to Geneva. Owing to special circumstances not known to the Committee at the time that decision was taken, the request was reconsidered at a later meeting. On the understanding that its action would not be taken as creating a precedent, the Committee authorized the Group of Experts to meet at Geneva.

2. Meetings of subsidiary organs of the General Assembly during the thirty-fifth session

5. By paragraph 24 of its decision 34/401, the General Assembly decided that subsidiary organs should be required to complete their work at the latest by 1 September, so that their reports may be available in all the working languages in time for consideration by the opening of the session of the General Assembly, and the Committee on Conferences should take this provision fully into account. Moreover, by paragraph 34 of the same decision, the Assembly decided that no subsidiary organ of the General Assembly should be permitted to meet at United Nations Headquarters during a regular session of the Assembly, unless explicitly authorized by the Assembly.

6. A number of requests to schedule additional meetings of subsidiary bodies of the General Assembly at dates later than those stipulated by the Assembly in the above-mentioned decision were submitted to the Committee on Conferences.

7. The Committee agreed to consider these requests after having been informed of a legal opinion by the Legal Counsel. This stated that under its mandate, as contained in Assembly resolution 32/72, the Committee on Conferences was the body empowered to act on behalf of the General Assembly in the planning of meetings and in the use of Conference facilities. Although the Assembly decided in its decision 34/401 that its subsidiary organs should not be permitted to meet at Headquarters during a regular session unless explicitly authorized to do so by the General Assembly, it must be assumed that this decision was not intended to frustrate the work of the Assembly or of its subsidiary bodies and that it was not possible to prevent bodies that must report to the Assembly from concluding their work and adopting their reports. The legal opinion concluded that the Committee on Conferences had the necessary authority to deal with the requests under consideration and to make the necessary conference facilities available on a provisional basis. The decisions of the Committee in this regard would, however, be subject to the approval of the General Assembly and should be brought to the attention of the Assembly at its thirty-fifth session when the report of the Committee on Conferences will be considered, thereby giving the Assembly an opportunity to confirm ex post facto or otherwise express itself on the course of action taken by the Committee on Conferences and thereby clarify its intentions with regard to the manner in which the provisions contained in paragraph 34 of its decision 34/401 are to be implemented.

8. The Committee observed that the requests received could be categorized as follows:

(a) Subsidiary organs that had not completed their reports by 1 September or, at the latest, prior to the opening of the thirty-fifth session of the General Assembly;

(b) Subsidiary organs that had not completed their substantive work by those dates;

(c) Subsidiary organs that requested, in view of their task, to be authorized to continue their activities throughout the session of the General Assembly.

9. The Committee then approved the requests by the Special Committee on Peace-Keeping Operations, the Working Group on the Financing of UNRWA, the Ad Hoc Committee on the Indian Ocean, the Committee of Trustees of the United Nations

Trust Fund for South Africa and the Advisory Committee on the United Nations Educational and Training Programme for Southern Africa, on dates later than those stipulated in General Assembly decision 34/101 in order to enable those bodies to finalize their reports for submission to the General Assembly.

10. For the same purpose it authorized meetings of the United Nations Council for Namibia, the Committee on Relations with the Host Country and the Committee on the Exercise of the Inalienable Rights of the Palestinian People. The Committee, however, decided that a decision whether the latter three bodies should be entitled to continue holding meetings of a substantive nature during the regular session of the Assembly should be referred to the General Committee of the General Assembly. It requested the Chairman of the Committee to take appropriate steps in that regard.

11. In view of these developments, the Committee considered that it should recommend to the General Assembly that it appeal to all subsidiary organs of the General Assembly and their chairmen to do their utmost to ensure that in future Assembly decision 34/401, in particular paragraphs 24 and 34, will be meticulously adhered to.

12. The Committee also considered that 1 September should be firmly observed as the deadline for the completion of work, including adoption of reports, by all subsidiary organs. Should circumstances arise when additional meetings are needed after that date and an organ is authorized to do so, any subsequent action should be reflected in an addendum to the report of that organ. The Committee therefore recommends to the General Assembly that it should affirm 1 September as the mandatory deadline for the completion of work, including adoption of reports, by subsidiary organs of the General Assembly and that any activity after the adoption of the reports by subsidiary organs that needs to be reported to the Assembly should be reflected in addenda to the reports of the organs concerned.

B. Revised calendar of conferences and meetings of the United Nations for 1981

13. The Committee on Conferences discussed the revised calendar of conferences and meetings of the United Nations for 1981, on the basis of a draft annual programme submitted by the Secretariat. This programme showed meetings of organs of the United Nations, their subsidiary bodies and expert groups. Conferences and meetings of the main legislative and executive bodies of the specialized agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency were also listed for information, with their dates and venues.

14. The Committee considered all changes and additions proposed as compared to the 1981 calendar of conferences and meetings approved by the General Assembly in decision 34/405 and issued in document A/AC.172/26 and recommends to the General Assembly that it approve the draft revised calendar for 1981 contained in annex II to the present report.

15. The Committee was also informed of the decision of the Third United Nations Conference on the Law of the Sea, taken at the end of the second part of its ninth session, to hold its tenth session from 9 March to 17 or 24 April 1981 at Headquarters, subject to approval by the General Assembly and to the availability of services. As the Conference requires four large conference rooms for eight meetings a day it would only, given the present schedule of meetings of various United Nations bodies at Headquarters, be possible to provide part of the required

facilities unless the meetings of some bodies are rescheduled so as to enable the Conference to be provided with all the services required.

16. In view of this, the Committee on Conferences recommends to the General Assembly that, in the event that the Assembly approves the recommendation of the Conference to hold its tenth session in New York, it should authorize the Committee on Conferences to meet during the thirty-fifth session in order to propose necessary adjustments in the calendar of the conferences for 1981 which may be required as a result of scheduling the tenth session of the Conference and, consequently, to enable the Assembly to consider fully any financial implications in that regard.

CHAPTER III

SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMITTEE ON CONFERENCES

17. The recommendations of the Committee on Conferences to the General Assembly, further to those contained in document A/35/32, are summarized below:

Recommendation 6:

The Committee recommends that the General Assembly should appeal to all subsidiary organs of the General Assembly and their chairmen to do their utmost to ensure that in future Assembly decision 34/401, in particular paragraphs 24 and 34, will be meticulously adhered to. [see para. 11]

Recommendation 7:

The Committee recommends that the General Assembly should affirm 1 September as the mandatory deadline for the completion of work, including adoption of the reports, by subsidiary organs of the General Assembly and that any activity after the adoption of the reports by subsidiary organs that needs to be reported to the Assembly should be reflected in addenda to the reports of the organs concerned. Recommendation 8:

The Committee recommends that the General Assembly approve the draft revised calendar for 1981 contained in annex II to the present report [see para. 14]

Recommendation 9:

The Committee recommends that, in the event that approval is given to the recommendation of the Third United Nations Conference on the Law of the Sea to hold its tenth session in New York, the General Assembly should authorize the Committee on Conferences to meet during the thirty-fifth session in order to propose necessary adjustments in the calendar of conferences for 1981 which may be required as a result of scheduling the tenth session of the Conference and, consequently, to enable the Assembly to consider fully any financial implications in that regard.
