REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVES AND DEPUTY AND ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL ELECTED FOR THE PERIOD 1988-1989

At its 40th meeting, on 15 October 1987, the General Assembly elected Algeria, Brazil, Nepal, Senegal and Yugoslavia as non-permanent members of the Security Council for a term of two years, beginning on 1 January 1988.

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that, with regard to the representation of the members of the Security Council elected for the period 1988-1989, he has received the communications referred to hereunder.

Algeria. Credentials signed on 16 November 1987 by the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Algeria state that Mr. Hocine Djoudi has been appointed representative of Algeria on the Security Council, Mr. M'Hamed Achache deputy representative and Mr. Ahmed Ouyahia, Mr. Ahmed Benyamina and Mr. Abdallah Baali alternate representatives.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.

Brazil. The Secretary-General has received a telegram dated 21 December 1987 from the Minister for External Relations of Brazil stating that Mr. Paulo Nogueira-Batista has been appointed representative of Brazil on the Security Council and Mr. Alvaro Gurgel de Alencar deputy representative.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this communication constitutes adequate provisional credentials.

Nepal. Credentials signed on 30 November 1987 by the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Nepal state that Mr. Jai Pratap Rana has been appointed representative of Nepal on the Security Council and Mr. Mana Ranjan Josse alternate representative.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.

Senegal. The Secretary-General has received a telegram dated 8 December 1987 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Senegal stating that Mr. Massamba Sarré has been appointed representative of Senegal on the Security Council, Mr. Saidou Nourou Ba deputy representative and Mr. Paul Badji, Mr. Moussa Bocar Ly and Mr. Aliou Sene alternate representatives.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this communication constitutes adequate provisional credentials.

Yugoslavia. Credentials signed on 20 November 1987 by the Federal Secretary for Foreign Affairs of Yugoslavia state that Mr. Dragošlav Pejić has been appointed representative of Yugoslavia on the Security Council, Mr. Dragomir Djokić deputy representative and Mr. Milišlav Pačić alternate representative.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.
