Scheme of Austria

Amendment

The Secretary-General of UNCTAD has received the following communication from the Permanent Mission of Austria regarding changes made in that country's scheme of generalized preferences:

- "- With effect from 1 May 1992, the Republic of Bosnia-Herzegovina has been included in the list of preference-receiving countries (Group I);
- With effectfrom 1 July 1992, the Democratic Republic of Madagascar is recognized as a least developed country and has been transferred into Group II of preference-receiving countries;
- With effect from 1 September 1992, Macedonia has been included in the list of preference-receiving countries (Group I)."
