PREPARATION OF A SUCCESSOR AGREEMENT TO THE INTERNATIONAL COCOA AGREEMENT, 1986

Draft resolution submitted by the President

The United Nations Cocoa Conference, 1992,

Having met in Geneva from 21 April to 1 May, from 6 to 24 July and from 2 to 13 November 1992,

Affirming its intention to negotiate an agreement with economic mechanisms,

Noting the narrowing of differences in the positions of States participating in the Conference,

Realizing that the development of mechanisms will require further time,

- 1. Affirms the determination of producing and consuming countries to conclude at a fourth part of the Conference the negotiation of a new international cocoa agreement;
- 2. Requests to this end the Secretary-General of UNCTAD to reconvene the Conference for a period of two weeks from 22 February to 5 March 1993;
- 3. Requests also the President of the Conference to maintain appropriate contacts with producing and consuming countries with a view to assisting the Conference in achieving a successful conclusion.
