Status of international conventions in the field of human rights  
in respect of which the Secretary-General performs depositary  
functions

### Report of the Secretary-General

1. In paragraph 4 of its resolution 3451 (XXX) of 9 December 1975, the General Assembly requested the Secretary-General to submit a report on the status of the international conventions in the field of human rights for which he acts as depositary.

2. The information in the present report on the status of these conventions has been extracted from the publication, entitled Multilateral Treaties in respect of which the Secretary-General Performs Depositary Functions, List of Signatures, Ratifications, Accessions, etc., as at 31 December 1979 (ST/LEG/SER.D/13), 1/ prepared by the Office of Legal Affairs of the Secretariat and brought up to date as at 30 June 1980. 2/

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a/ Following on the adoption of resolution 2758 (XXVI) of 25 October 1971 on the lawful rights of the People's Republic of China in the United Nations by the General Assembly, the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China, by a note addressed to the Secretary-General, received on 29 September 1972, stated:

"1. With regard to the multilateral treaties signed, ratified or acceded to by the defunct Chinese government before the establishment of the Government of the People's Republic of China, my Government will examine their contents before making a decision in the light of the circumstances as to whether or not they should be recognized.

"2. As from 1 October 1949, the day of the founding of the People's Republic of China, the Chiang Kai-shek clique has no right at all to represent China. Its signature and ratification of, or accession to, any multilateral treaties by usurping the name of 'China' are all illegal and null and void. My Government will study these multilateral treaties before making a decision in the light of the circumstances as to whether or not they should be acceded to."

The lists therefore do not indicate that, subsequent to 1 October 1949, and prior to 25 October 1971, the "Republic of China" (a) ratified, acceded to or accepted the conventions listed above under the numbers (6), (11), (12), (15), (16) and (17), and (b) signed, but did not ratify the conventions listed under numbers (1), (2), (3) and (13) and that the convention listed under number (4) was signed on behalf of the "Republic of China" on 20 July 1949 and an instrument of ratification by the "Republic of China" was deposited on 19 July 1951.

At the time of preparing this publication no indication had been received from the Government of Viet Nam regarding its position with respect to a possible succession.

The conventions listed under numbers (4) and (16) were acceded to by the Republic of South Viet-Nam on 11 August 1950 and 14 August 1956, respectively. The convention listed under number (17) was signed on behalf of the Republic of South Viet-Nam on 7 September 1956.
