## REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

## Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. On 17 July 1992, the Director-General of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) addressed a letter to the Secretary-General (E/1992/113), to which was annexed resolution 5.6 of the General Conference of UNESCO entitled "Consultations with the United Nations with a view to declaring 1995 United Nations year for tolerance". In paragraph 2 (d) of that resolution, the General Conference invited the Director-General "to examine, in consultation with the United Nations, the appropriate arrangements for declaring 1995, which is the fiftieth anniversary of UNESCO, United Nations year for tolerance, and to prepare a declaration on tolerance that might be discussed and possibly adopted on that occasion".
- 2. By its decision 1992/267 of 30 July 1992, the Economic and Social Council took note of the letter and decided to transmit it to the Assembly at its forty-seventh session for consideration.
