At its 49th meeting, on 1 December 1987, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/42/47) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee in paragraph 10 of its report (A/42/816). DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee in paragraph 10 of its report (A/42/816), no modification in the programme of work for 1988-1989 as proposed in the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1988-1989 would be required, and that no additional appropriation over and above those contained in sections 26 and 29 of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1988-1989 would be required.
