- 1. At its 54th meeting, on 4 December 1987, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/42/53) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution D recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 27 of its report (A/42/811). The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/42/SR.54).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 76 to 2, with 20 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution D recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 27 of its report (A/42/811), no additional appropriation would be required under the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1988-1989.

Against: Israel, United States of America.

Abstaining: Australia, Austria, Belgium, Cameroon, Canada, Central African Republic, Denmark, France, Germany, Federal Republic of, Honduras, Iceland, Italy, Japan, Malawi, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Zaire.

5. A statement in explanation of vote was made by the representative of Jordan.
