REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL IN PURSUANCE OF  
SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 552 (1984)

Addendum

1. It will be recalled that, in accordance with Security Council resolution 552 (1984) of 1 June 1984, the Secretary-General submitted to the Security Council, on 31 December 1984, a report (S/16877) which had been requested of him under paragraph 7 of that resolution. Addenda to that report (S/16877/Add.1, Add.2, Add.3 and Corr.1 and Add.4) were issued on 22 January 1985, 31 December 1985, 31 December 1986, 22 January 1987 and 10 February 1987 respectively.
2. The Secretary-General has continued to receive substantial information regarding incidents relevant to his reporting responsibility under resolution 552 (1984), mainly from the International Maritime Organization (IMO), which is reproduced in the annex to the present addendum to the report.
3. Additionally, a letter dated 28 January 1987 was received from the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland referring to an incident on 23 January 1987 which involved a British-owned and registered vessel - the M/V Isomeria. Four communications relevant to this report were also received from the Government of Kuwait. The first, dated 1 July 1987, concerned the attack on 30 June 1987 on the container ship, Al Merqaab, which was owned by the United Arab Shipping Company and carried the Kuwaiti flag. A second letter, dated 1 September 1987, reported an attack on 31 August 1987 on a vessel of the same ownership and flag, Jabal Ali, and a third, dated 15 October 1987, reported an attack on that day on a Liberian tanker in Kuwaiti territorial waters. A fourth letter, dated 16 October 1987, reported a missile attack on that date on an oil tanker registered in the United States and anchored in Kuwaiti territorial waters. The last three letters have been issued as documents of the Security Council (S/19093, S/19210 and S/19215).
4. The Secretary-General continues to be deeply concerned by the continuing attacks on merchant vessels. This year has witnessed a more than 50 per cent increase in such incidents over last year, which have had devastating effects for the shipping industry. The Secretary-General once again strongly calls on both

parties involved in the conflict to exercise utmost restraint and to put an end to the incidents which are causing loss of innocent lives and exacerbating tension in the region. These deplorable actions underline the urgency of upholding the principle of freedom of navigation in international waters.
