STATUS OF THE CONVENTION ON THE ELIMINATION OF ALL FORMS OF DISCRIMINATION AGAINST WOMEN

Report of the Secretary-General

- 1. The General Assembly, by its resolution 34/180 of 18 December 1979, adopted and opened for signature, ratification and accession the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women and expressed the hope that the Convention would be signed and ratified or acceded to without delay and would come into force at an early date. The Secretary-General was requested to present the text of the Convention to the World Conference of the United Nations Decade for Women for its information, and to submit to the General Assembly at its thirty-fifth session a report concerning the status of the Convention.
- 2. The Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women was opened for signature in New York on 1 March 1980. It will enter into force on the thirtieth day after the date of deposit with the Secretary-General of the United Nations of the twentieth instrument of ratification or accession, as provided for in article 27 of the Convention.
- 3. The Economic and Social Council, in resolution 1980/34 of 2 May 1980, expressed the hope that the Convention would come into force at an early date and urged Governments to take the necessary steps in order to sign, ratify and/or accede to the Convention. The Council requested the Secretary-General to arrange a ceremony for signing the Convention, to take place during the World Conference of the United Nations Decade for Women.
- 4. On the occasion of the signing ceremony, which the Secretary-General arranged at Copenhagen during the Conference, on Thursday, 17 July 1980, 52 States signed the Convention and two countries deposited their instruments of ratification, and on other occasions during the Conference, 12 other States signed the Convention.
- 5. As at 14 August 1980, the Convention had received 76 signatures, 6 of which had been followed by ratifications.

6. The list of States which have signed and ratified the Convention, as well as the dates of their signatures and ratifications, is contained in annex I to the present report. The texts of reservations made by States at the time of ratification appear in annex II.
