QUESTION OF THE COMPOSITION OF THE RELEVANT ORGANS
OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Report of the Special Political Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Yuriy SHEVCHENKO (Ukraine)

- 1. The item entitled "Question of the composition of the relevant organs of the United Nations" was included in the provisional agenda of the forty-seventh session of the General Assembly in accordance with Assembly decision 46/415 of 9 December 1991.
- 2. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 18 September 1992, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include the item in its agenda and to allocate it to the Special Political Committee.
- 3. At the 5th meeting of the Special Political Committee, on 26 October, the Chairman proposed that, as no member of the Committee had requested to speak on the substance of the item, consideration of it should be deferred until the forty-eighth session.
- 4. In the absence of any objection, it was so decided.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE SPECIAL POLITICAL COMMITTEE

5. The Special Political Committee recommends that the General Assembly should include in the provisional agenda of its forty-eighth session the item entitled "Question of the composition of the relevant organs of the United Nations".
