NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At its 84th meeting on 14 December 1978, the General Assembly adopted resolution 33/63,* entitled "Implementation of the Declaration on the Denuclearization of Africa". In paragraph 4 of that resolution, the General Assembly

"Requests the Security Council to exercise a close watch on South Africa and to take appropriate effective steps to prevent South Africa from developing and acquiring nuclear weapons which endanger international peace and security."
