LETTER DATED 18 NOVEMBER 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE
PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Acting under paragraph 5 of Security Council resolution 771 (1992) of 13 August 1992 and paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 780 (1992) of 6 October 1992, wherein the Security Council called "upon States ... to collate substantiated information in their possession or submitted to them relating to the violations of humanitarian law, including grave breaches of the Geneva Conventions, being committed in the territory of the former Yugoslavia" and to make this information available to the Council, I have the honour to present to you the attached 17 reports entitled "War Crimes Investigation and Documentation"* pertaining to witness interviews conducted by the Bosnia and Herzegovina Information Centre in London, on or about 31 October 1992.

May I ask for your kind assistance in having these reports made available to the Commission of Experts established pursuant to resolution 780 (1992).
