NOTE VERBALE DATED 5 NOVEMBER 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT  
REPRESENTATIVE OF LATVIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED  
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Latvia to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to his note dated 3 June 1992 concerning Security Council resolution 757 (1992) of 30 May 1992.

In this connection, the Permanent Representative of Latvia to the United Nations has the honour to inform the Secretary-General that the Council of Ministers of Latvia adopted a decision (No. 429) on 16 October 1992 entitled "Economic and other types of sanctions against the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro)", which includes the following provisions:

1. All physical and juridical persons must halt exports to and imports from the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro), except exports intended for medical purposes and foodstuffs notified to the United Nations by way of the Ministry for Foreign Affairs.
2. Maritime vessels and aircraft of Latvia are prohibited from transporting cargo if it is in any way connected with exports to or imports from the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro).
3. Maritime vessels of third countries are prohibited from entering harbours in Latvia, and aircraft of third countries are prohibited from landing in or flying over the territory of Latvia, if such maritime vessels and aircraft are coming from or going to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro).
4. All scientific, technical, cultural and athletic cooperation with the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro) must be halted.
5. All physical and juridical persons in Latvia must comply with any other restrictions in Security Council resolution 757 (1992).
