NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At its 91st meeting on 21 December 1978, the General Assembly adopted resolution 33/182 B,* entitled "Question of Namibia". In paragraph 8 of that resolution, the General Assembly

"Requests the Security Council to consider as a matter of urgency further appropriate action under the Charter, including Chapter VII thereof, in order to secure South Africa's compliance with its relevant resolutions".
