ELECTIONS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS AND OTHER ELECTIONS:

- (a) ELECTION OF TWELVE MEMBERS OF THE WORLD FOOD COUNCIL: NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL (A/47/401)
- (b) ELECTION OF SEVEN MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE FOR PROGRAMME AND COORDINATION: NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL (A/47/402)

The PRESIDENT: The Assembly will first consider sub-item (a) of agenda item 16, "Election of twelve members of the World Food Council".

In accordance with resolution 3348 (XXIX) of 17 December 1974, the General Assembly elects the members of the World Food Council upon the nomination of the Economic and Social Council.

The Assembly has before it document A/47/401, which contains the nominations by the Economic and Social Council to fill the vacancies in the World Food Council that will occur as a result of the expiration on 31 December 1992 of the terms of office of Argentina, Burundi, Denmark, Egypt, France, Hungary, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Italy, Japan, Peru, Rwanda and Yemen.

The following States have been nominated by the Economic and Social Council: three African States for three vacancies - Guinea-Bissau, Nigeria and Tunisia; two Asian States for three vacancies - the Islamic Republic of Iran and Japan; one Eastern European State for one vacancy - Hungary; two Latin American and Caribbean States for two vacancies - Ecuador and Peru; and three Western European and Other States for three vacancies - France, Italy and Norway.
