Award of human rights prizes in 1993

The General Assembly, on the recommendation of the Third Committee, considering that the year 1993 will mark the forty-fifth anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, bearing in mind the need to promote the universal observance and enjoyment of human rights, and recalling its resolution 2217 (XXI) which approved the award of prizes in the field of human rights, decided: to request the Secretary-General to make the neessary arrangements for the award of human rights prizes in 1993, as envisaged in recommendation C of the annex to General Assembly resolution 2217 A (XXI) of 19 December 1966.
