# REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON THE UNITED NATIONS OBSERVER MISSION IN EL SALVADOR

#### Addendum

- 1. In my report to the Security Council of 23 November 1992 (S/24833), I recommended that the Council extend the mandate of the United Nations Observer Mission in El Salvador (ONUSAL) for a further period of six months, to 31 May 1993. A preliminary cost estimate of such an extension, should the Security Council decide to approve it, is provided for information purposes in the annex to the present addendum.
- 2. It would be my recommendation to the General Assembly that the cost relating to the extension of ONUSAL's mandate should be considered an expense of the Organization to be borne by Member States in accordance with Article 17, paragraph 2, of the Charter of the United Nations and that the assessments to be levied on Member States be credited to the ONUSAL special account.
