LETTER DATED 9 NOVEMBER 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF FRANCE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF
THE SECURITY COUNCIL

My Government is gravely concerned by the current situation in the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

In its resolution 713 (1991) and in all its subsequent resolutions, the Security Council undertook to pursue consideration of this issue.

Consequently, on instructions from my Government, I have the honour to request that you convene an urgent meeting of the Security Council for the purpose of examining the current situation in the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

At this meeting, the Council might find it of value to hear Mr. Mazowiecki. I propose, therefore, that under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure, the Security Council should invite Mr. Mazowiecki to speak before it.
