## REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON THE UNITED NATIONS operation in mozambique (ontmoz)

## Addendum

1. As stated in paragraph 54 of my main report ( $\mathrm{S} / 24892$ ). I indicated that an addenaum to the raport would be issued which would contain preliminary cost estimates related to the establishment and deploymeat of a United Nations Operation in mozambique (ONJMOz).
2. Based on the operational plan and general assumptions outlined in my main report, it is sstimated that an amount of $\$ 331.8$ million would be required for the period from inception to 31 October 1993. This amount includes the costs of start-up and acquisition of capital ecuipment. A breakdown of the estimated cost by main objects of expend: ture is provided for information purposes in the amnes to the present ad, noun.
3. It would be my recomr:endation to the General Assembly that, should the Security Council agree to the establishment and deployment of ONUMOZ, the cost relating thereto should be considered as an expense of che organization to be borne by Member States in accordance with Article 17, paragrapin 2, of the Charter of the United Nations and that the assessment to be levied on Member States be credited to a special acsount to be.estailished for this puipose.
