**LETTER DATED 1 DECEMBER 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO
THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL**

Serbian and Montenegrin aggression against the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina continues undiminished. The aggression has especially intensified in central Bosnia and Herzegovina, where Serbian and Montenegrin forces are taking all measures to reinforce and expand a corridor linking conquered territory in Bosnia and Herzegovina and Croatia to Belgrade.

In pursuit of this corridor, Serbian and Montenegrin forces have focused heavy artillery, infantry and helicopters on the town of Gradacac, which consequently suffered a high number of civilian casualties and severe structural damage.

In fact, in Jiddah, Saudi Arabia, where foreign ministers are gathered on the eve of the sixth extraordinary session of the Organization of the Islamic Conference, Saudi Arabian television aired new footage of helicopters attacking Gradacac. These attacks constitute gross violations of Security Council resolution 781 (1992) of 9 October 1992.

May I ask for your kind assistance in circulating this letter as a document of the Security Council.
