LETTER DATED 7 DECEMBER 1992 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Further to my letter dated 4 December 1992 (S/24900) and in accordance with paragraph 4 of Security Council resolution 781 (1992) of 9 October 1992, I should like to share with the Council further information received by the United Nations Protection Force (UNPROFOR) regarding apparent violations of the ban on military flights in the airspace of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Between 4 and 6 December 1992, there appear to have been 19 flights of fixed- or rotary-wing aircraft in the airspace of Bosnia and Herzegovina other than those exempted in accordance with paragraph 1 of resolution 781 (1992) or approved by UNPROFOR in accordance with paragraph 3 of that resolution. In addition, information has become available about another 3 flights between 1 and 2 December that were not listed in my letter dated 4 December. Details as to the time and the itinerary of these flights are attached in annexes I and II to the present letter.

All confirmed violations were immediately protested by UNPROFOR to the party concerned.

| 268 | 4 December | 0607 | 0611 | AWACS tracked an aircraft from overhead the airfield at Kolanska to overhead Zaluzani airfield. This track was probably a helicopter. | East 70 KTS Unknown |
| 269 | 4 December | 0621 | 0623 | AWACS tracked an aircraft from overhead Zaluzani airfield flying along the valley to the north-east. The speed of the track indicates a fixed-wing aircraft. | North-east 300 KTS Unknown |
| 270 | 4 December | 0700 | 0704 | AWACS tracked an aircraft crossing over the ridge to the north of Banja Luka town. This was probably a fixed-wing aircraft. | North-east 240 KTS Unknown |
| 271 | 4 December | 0702 | 0704 | AWACS tracked an aircraft flying from just north of Mahovljani airfield towards the boundary of the "No Fly Zone". It crossed out of the zone to the south of Nova Gradiskas. The speed of the track indicates that this was a fixed-wing aircraft. | North-east 300 KTS Unknown |
| 272 | 4 December | 0711 | 0713 | AWACS tracked an aircraft flying from the north-west of Derventa towards the area 5 nm to the south of the town. This track could have been a fixed-wing aircraft or a helicopter. | South-east 136 KTS Unknown |

| 274 | 4 December | 0907 | 1010 | An MI-8 helicopter was observed taking off and later landing at Zaluzani airfield. This mission was declared, but not confirmed, as a training flight. The helicopter was fitted with weapons pylons. | North Slow 500 feet |
| 275 | 4 December | 0912 | 0918 | AWACS tracked an aircraft flying from overhead Mahovljani airfield to overhead Zaluzani airfield. The track was probably a helicopter. | South-west 100 KTS Unknown |
| 276 | 4 December | 0925 | 1131 | A Gazelle helicopter was observed taking off and landing at Zaluzani airfield. This mission was declared, but not confirmed, as a training flight. The UNMO team was unable to check the aircraft for weapons. | North-east Fast 300 feet |
| 277 | 4 December | 0951 | 0957 | AWACS tracked an aircraft crossing over the ridge to the south of the town of Sanski Most. This track could have been a fixed-wing aircraft or a helicopter. | North-east 142 KTS Unknown |
| 278 | 4 December | 1013 | 1123 | An MI-8 helicopter was observed taking off and landing at Zaluzani airfield. The declared, but not confirmed, mission was a training flight. The helicopter was fitted with weapons pylons. | South Slow 500 feet |
| 279 | 4 December | 1809 | 1851 | A CASA-212, registration FGH0X, was observed landing at Cazin airfield. It was carrying a cargo of 50 boxes. The UNMOs were told that these boxes contained medicine. It departed later with casualties. This aircraft was observed landing at Pleso airfield at 2040 by UNMOs. | |

| 282 | 5 December | 0720 | 0804 | AWACS detected an aircraft 30 nm south-west of Mahovljani airfield flying north-east to a position 10 miles north-west of Brcko and then turning back to the west towards Mahovljani airfield. This track was identified as an N-62 (Super Galeb) taking off from Mahovljani airfield at 0720 and landing at 0804. No ordnance was observed. | Various High Medium |
| 283 | 5 December | 0833 | 0945 | An MI-8 helicopter, tail number 12368, was observed taking off from Zaluzani airfield. The UNMOs were informed that the destination was Bosanski Petrovac. It landed later at the same airfield. No ordnance was observed. AWACS confirmed an aircraft, probably a helicopter, was flying 20 nm north of Bosanski Petrovac. | South Fast 200 feet |
| 284 | 6 December | ... | 1450 | A Gazelle helicopter, tail number 12756, was observed by UNMOs landing at Zaluzani airfield. The helicopter landed directly inside a hangar, without radio contact with the air traffic control tower. The UNMOs were denied access to this hangar. The helicopter was fitted with weapon pylons. | North Fast 200 feet |
