LETTER DATED 3 DECEMBER 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE  
OF PAKISTAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT  
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer the consideration by the Security Council of the situation in Somalia and the letters of the Secretary-General dated 24 and 29 November 1992, to the Council on the subject.

As you are aware, an infantry battalion from Pakistan has already been deployed in Mogadishu as part of the United Nations Operation in Somalia. Moreover, the additional elements for UNOSOM agreed to between the United Nations and the Government of Pakistan are ready for deployment in Somalia.

As a troop-contributing country, it is the hope of my Government that it will be consulted by the Security Council and the Secretariat on measures that are being contemplated to be taken in the future which may affect the mandate of UNOSOM.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
