LETTER DATED 25 NOVEMBER 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE  
OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO  
THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to paragraph 5 of Security Council resolution 771 (1992) of 13 August 1992 and paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 780 (1992) of 6 October 1992, in which the Council "calls upon States ... to collate substantiated information in their possession or submitted to them relating to the violations of humanitarian law, including grave breaches of the Geneva conventions, 1/ being committed in the territory of the former Yugoslavia and to make this information available to the Council", I have the honour to present to you the attached report "Bulletin", dated October 1992 and published by the State Commission for Gathering Facts on War Crimes in the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina.\*

The State Commission is prepared to present its findings related to this report and to many other documents to the Security Council, the Secretary-General and the Commission of Experts established pursuant to resolution 780 (1992), collectively or individually.

May I ask for your kind assistance in having these reports made available to the Commission of Experts.
