REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

Report of the Second Committee (Part I)*

Rapporteur: Mr. Walter BALZAN (Malta)

I. INTRODUCTION

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 18 September 1992, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its forty-seventh session the item entitled "Report of the Economic and Social Council" and to allocate to the Second Committee chapters of the Council's report (A/47/3 and Add.1) 1/ that were considered under the relevant items of the agenda (see A/C.2/47/1).

2. In the context of item 12, the Second Committee considered the following questions referred by the Economic and Social Council to the General Assembly that did not fall within the purview of items specifically allocated to the Second Committee:

- (a) International cooperation in tax matters;
- (b) Transnational corporations;
- (c) International Conference on Population and Development;

- (d) Consumer protection;
- (e) Prevention and control of acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS);
- (f) Permanent sovereignty over national resources in the occupied Palestinian and other Arab territories;
- (g) Public administration and finance;
- (h) Second Industrial Development Decade for Africa, 1991-2000;
- (i) Combating aridity, soil erosion, salinity, waterlogging, desertification and the effects of drought in South Asia.

3. The Committee considered the item at its 34th to 37th, 40th, 42nd, 43rd, 45th, 46th _____ meetings, on 10, 11, 16, 18, 19, 24, 25 _____ November. At the 34th meeting, on 10 November, introductory statements were made by the Under-Secretary-General for Economic and Social Development and the Acting Director of the World Health Organization's Office at the United Nations in New York. The Executive Director of the United Nations Population Fund made a statement in her capacity as Secretary-General of the International Conference on Population and Development, 1994 (see A/C.2/47/SR.34).

II. CONSIDERATION OF DRAFT RESOLUTION A/C.2/47/L.54

6. At the 46th meeting, on 25 November, the Vice-Chairman of the Committee, Miss Maymouna Diop (Senegal), introduced a draft resolution, which she submitted on the basis of informal consultations, entitled "Prevention and control of acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS)" (A/C.2/47/L.54).

7. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft resolution A/C.2/47/L.54, without a vote (see para. 8).

III. RECOMMENDATION OF THE SECOND COMMITTEE

8. The Second Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

Prevention and control of acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS)

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 46/203 of 20 December 1991, previous resolutions of the General Assembly and relevant resolutions of other organizations of the United Nations system,

1. Takes note of the report of the Director-General of the World Health Organization on the implementation of the global strategy for the prevention and control of acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS); 2/

2. Endorses the action taken by the Economic and Social Council in resolution 1992/33 of 30 July 1992 on prevention and control of AIDS;

[3. Requests the Secretary-General to invite the Director-General of the World Health Organization, in close collaboration with all other appropriate bodies, organs and programmes of the United Nations system, to report, through the Secretary-General, to the General Assembly, at its forty-eighth session and biennially thereafter, through the Economic and Social Council, on progress in the implementation of the global strategy for the prevention and control of AIDS.]
