1. At its 42nd meeting, on 11 December 1992, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/47/54) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution entitled "United Nations African Institute for the Prevention of Crime and the Treatment of Offenders" recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 30 of its report (A/47/703). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by the Chairman of the Fifth Committee.
