> APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS AND OTHER APPOINTMENTS

CONFIRMATION OF THE APPOINTMENT OF THREE MEMBERS OF THE INVESTMENTS CONMITTEE

Note by the Secretary-General

1. In accordance with the provisions of article 20 of the regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, the Secretary-General, after consultation with the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, submits for confirmation by the General Assembly the following appointments as members of the United Nations Investments Committee.

For three-year terms, from 1 January 1981

Messrs. David Montagu (reappointment), Yves Oltramare (reappointment) and Emmanuel Noi Omaboe (also known as Nana Wereko Ampem II) (new appointment).

2. Ir. Hontagu was first appointed to the Committee for a three-year term commencing in 1972, and Mr. Oltramare was first appointed to the Committee for a full term commencing in 1975 after serving in an <u>ad hoc</u> consultative capacity during 1974. The Secretary-General very much appreciates their willingness to continue to carry on this important international public service.

3. The term of the late 'ir. Hamzah Merghani would have expired on 31 December 1980. The Secretary-General has asked, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly, 'ir. Omaboe to serve on the Committee for a three-year term commencing in 1981.

For a one-year term from 1 January 1981

Mr. George Johnston (new appointment).

4. Mr. R. Manning Brown, Jr., who was first appointed to the Committee for a full term commencing in 1973, has indicated that he will be unable to complete

his term expiring 31 December 1981. To replace Mr. Brown, the Secretary-General believes that, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly, Mr. George Johnston should be appointed to the Committee for a one-year term commencing in 1981.

5. The advice of the Investments Committee in the invaluable to the Secretary-General and his predecessors in care they out their responsibilities for the investment of the assets of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund. As the Secretary-General has stated to the Joint Staff Pension Board and the Advisory Committee, he draws, in addition, upon such specialized expertise as may be advisable, having in mind the investments of the Fund.

6. In order to provide for continuity in the membership of the Investments Committee, the terms of the members have been staggered. If the General Assembly confirms the proposed appointments, the United Nations Investments Committee would consist of the following members:

Mr. George Johnston, Mr. Jean Guyot and Mr. Toshio Shishido, whose terms of office will expire 31 December 1981;

Mr. Aloysio de Andrade Faria, Mr. B. K. Nehru and Mr. Stanislaw Raczkowski, whose terms of office expire on 31 December 1982;

Mr. David Montagu, Mr. Yves Oltramare and Mr. Annanuel Noi Omaboe, whose terms of office expire on 31 December 1983.
