Letter dated 30 December 1992 from the President of Bosnia and Herzegovina addressed to the President of the Security Council

Yesterday a military convoy from Serbia (eight tanks, fifteen military trucks with soldiers) entered the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina crossing the bridge on the river Drina near Bratunac, Eastern Bosnia. Many foreign agencies have independently reported about this.

We urge you to use your influence so that these troops be returned to Serbia.

All this would not have happened if the conclusions of the London Conference and the previous United Nations resolutions had been implemented.
