NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

1. At the 51st plenary meeting of its forty-second session, on 28 October 1987, the General Assembly adopted resolution 42/9, entitled "Co-operation between the United Nations and the Organization of African Unity". 1/
2. In paragraph 16 of the resolution, the General Assembly:

"Calls upon the United Nations organs - in particular the Security Council, the Economic and Social Council, the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples, the Special Committee against Apartheid and the United Nations Council for Namibia - to continue to associate closely the Organization of African Unity with all their activities concerning Africa;"
