### PROPOSED PROGRAMME BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM 1992-1993

#### The contingency fund: consolidated statement of programme budget implications and revised estimates

#### Report of the Secretary-General

1. The consolidated statement of programme budget implications and revised estimates falling under the guidelines for the contingency fund contained in the annex to resolution 42/211 of 21 December 1987 is submitted in the annex to the present document. The amounts contained in respect of each item correspond to those previously recommended by the Fifth Committee upon its consideration of individual statements and proposals for revised estimates.

2. It may be recalled that the level of the contingency fund for the biennium 1992-1993 initially set at \$19 million by the General Assembly in resolution 45/255 of 21 December 1990 was revised to \$18 million in General Assembly resolution 46/185 B, section IX. By resolution 46/185 A, section IX, the General Assembly noted that a balance of \$15,237,100 remained in the contingency fund. The consolidated amount is within the available balance of the contingency fund. It is proposed, therefore, that the Fifth Committee, in accordance with paragraph 5 of the annex to resolution 42/211, proceed to recommend to the Assembly the appropriation of the required amounts under the relevant sections of the programme budget, as follows:
